Technology Assisted Learning Council

Membership – (1) Faculty representative from each school, and (2) CIO appointees. Chair to be selected by the council from the faculty appointees.

Meetings – The Technology Assisted Learning Council will meet formally on a semi-annual basis or more frequently at the call of the Chair.

Scope of Responsibilities –

The Technology Assisted Learning Council will provide the leadership and expertise needed to design and maintain an environment for faculty to have the skills and support systems necessary to effectively incorporate technology into pedagogy. In collaboration with the CIO, the Council will be the primary advisory body for:

- Developing faculty requirements and strategies in the areas of –
 - Training,
 - Curriculum development support,
 - Peer review and mentoring,
- Creating a technology assisted curriculum environment based on learning objectives, and
- Developing an organizational vehicle, at the institutional level, to enhance faculty collaboration.
