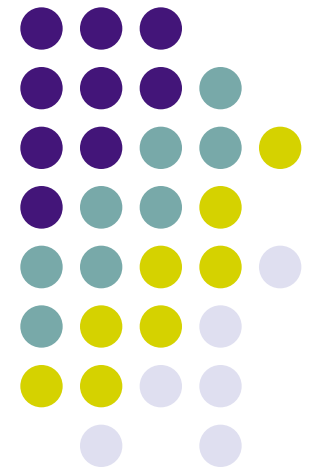

KEYWORD SEARCHING: We'll begin by conducting a keyword search from the Basic Search screen with the available **Search Options** set to open. Enter **migraine** in the **Find** field, check the Full Text limiter to restrict results to those including full text only, and then click **Search** to view a Result List of all articles that contain your term in one of the citation fields.
