

Borrowing Policies

- A library card is required for checking out all items
- General Collection items circulate for two weeks and may be renewed twice for additional two-week periods
- Reserve items circulate for two hours
- Audiovisual items circulate for ten days and may have one renewal
- Journals, computer disks, models, and reference materials do **not** circulate
- A total of 12 items may be checked out at any given time
- Borrowed books may be renewed by calling **806-743-2200**; audiovisual renewals by calling **806-743-2213**
- Overdue items and items on hold may **not** be renewed
- Borrowed **books** may be returned to either the Circulation counter or to designated book drops. Borrowed **audiovisual** materials must be returned to the LRC Circulation counter
- Overdue Audiovisual materials or General Collection items accrue fines of \$.50 per **day** for each item
- Overdue Reserve items accrue fines of \$.50 per **hour** for each item
- For lost or damaged items, the borrower is responsible for the replacement cost of each item, a \$25.00 processing fee, and all accrued overdue fines
- Borrowing privileges are suspended until all overdue items are returned and all fines are paid

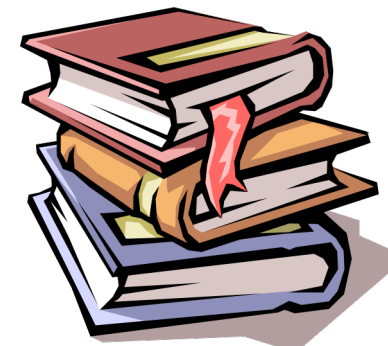
Other Services

- Individual literature searches are available upon request for a fee.
- Six public access computers are located on the Library's second floor. Laser-quality printouts are available for \$0.10 per page. Additional computers that require an HSC eRaider account are located throughout the third floor.
- LRC computers, scanners, and printers are available to eligible borrowers for educational purposes only.
- IBM or Mac diskettes and CD-ROMs can be purchased for \$1 each. Zip disks are available for \$15.
