### ➤ Services Provided

#### ➤ Housing

- 1, 3 B/2 Ba for 3 families
- 1 Duplex for 2 families – “Transitional Housing”
- 1, 3 B/2 Ba for 1 family – “Transitional Housing”

#### ➤ Education

- Getting them registered for Medicaid. Food Stamps, Blue Card for Lubbock, finding jobs, pursuit of \*Certifications\*

#### ➤ Prevention

- Funding to prevent eviction

### ➤ Clients' Health Needs

- Childcare/ Emergency Services for their children
- Women's Health

### ➤ Clients' Health Information Needs

- When not to go to the ER for varying illnesses
- Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) hinder the development of the children
- Vaccinations education

### ➤ Advice for Physicians

- Care about your patient's story
  - Adults are apprehensive about getting care to begin with, take the time to get to know them
- Be sure to pay attention to know how to work with different types of abuse: neglect, abuse, relationship-related
- Know the available resources to direct families to
- Understand the level of your patient – Don't preach about them eating health and exercising when they work every day and are forced to pick up McDonald's for convenience/price
