## **COVID's impact**

- Move to telehealth counseling
- More severe physical abuse cases
- Less reporting because of remote school -- educators main reporters

### **Advice for Physicians**

- → Have patience and empathy
- Be diligent reporters
- **◄ Listen to histories carefully**
- **尽** Be aware of abuse when you see it
  - ▶ Does the story match the injuries and symptoms?
  - Can you speak to the child by themselves in a safe env.?
