Advice for Physicians

- Prioritize Patient Trust: Establish a trusting relationship with both the child and their nonoffending caregivers. A safe environment will make it easier for them to disclose sensitive information.
- Continuing Education: Regularly attend training sessions on child abuse awareness and prevention. The symptoms and signs of abuse evolve, and staying updated ensures the best care for your patients.
- Multidisciplinary Collaboration: Collaborate closely with therapists, social workers, and other professionals involved in the child's care. A team approach ensures comprehensive understanding and effective response.
- Screening Protocols: Integrate routine screening for signs of abuse during check-ups, especially if the child exhibits unexplained behavioral changes, regressions, or physical signs.
