Guidelines for Arriving Students in the Graduate Program in Pharmaceutical Sciences

- Incoming students must report to the Graduate Program Coordinator in the Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences office in Amarillo one week prior to the "First day of Classes" as set by the TTUHSC School of Pharmacy for the term they are enrolling. Students must be enrolled and in attendance for the "First Day of Classes" as set by the TTUHSC School of Pharmacy.
- 2. Incoming students are required to attend <u>all</u> sessions of Graduate Student Orientation. Students arriving in the Spring or Summer must attend the following Fall Orientation sessions.
- All students must register for at least 9 credit hours of graduate study no later than the published "12th Class Day" as set by the TTUHSC Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences. Failure to register for the required hours by the "12th Class Day" will result in termination from the Graduate Program in Pharmaceutical Sciences.
- 4. All payments, or arrangement for payment of tuition and fees must be made by the published "Last date to make Payment" as set by the TTUHSC Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences. Failure to make payment or arrangement for payment by this date will result in termination from the Graduate Program in Pharmaceutical Sciences.
- 5. Incoming students are required to complete faculty visitations within 10 days of the end of Graduate Student Orientation.
- 6. All students must complete one full lab rotation before any lab assignments are considered permanent.
- 7. Graduate Student Stipends, whether funded by the State or through alternative sources, are provided on a yearly basis and no stipend is guaranteed for the full period of studies.
