

Guidelines for Graduate Faculty Appointments for the Graduate Program in Pharmaceutical Sciences

Graduate Faculty Appointments are approved by voting graduate faculty members in the Graduate Program in Pharmaceutical Sciences as defined by the GSBS Bylaws. Non-tenured track faculty will only be considered for an associate appointment with the following conditions.

Conditions of Associate Appointment:

Privileges include:

- Teaching in GPPS course
- Serving as a voting member of the committee for students

Restrictions include:

- Serving as the instructor of record
- Serving as chair of a the committee for students
- Voting on issues pertaining to GPPS curriculum requirements, graduate course content, and changes in GPPS guidelines
- Serving on Graduate Council and voting in the election of members to the GSBS Graduate Council
- Voting in the election of Officers of the GSBS Graduate Faculty and on general GSBS issues.
