

2017 Pharmacy Practice Seed Grant Program

Texas Tech School of Pharmacy is pleased to provide funding for pharmacy practice faculty seed grants and issues the following Request for Proposals (RFP). A total of \$5,000 is available to support up to 2 applications. Award funding will be determined on a case-by-case basis. Eligibility for this RFP is limited to faculty in the Pharmacy Practice Department.

Proposal Submission Timeline:

Submit to Dr. Richard Leff, Senior Associate Dean for Clinical & Translational Research on or **before 5:00 pm CST, March 31, 2017 for consideration**. Award funding will be made available September 1, 2017 for a period of up to one year. A progress report will be required.

Proposal Submission Guidelines:

Proposals should not be greater than a total of eight (8) double-spaced pages in 12-point type and each proposal should include the following:

- I. Hypothesis
- II. Literature Summary
- III. Specific Aims
- IV. Methods
- V. Analysis
- VI. Study Timeline (Proposals requiring longer than 10 months to complete will not be considered)
- VII. Budget & Budget Justification
- VIII. Dissemination of Results
- IX. References

Proposal Evaluation:

Proposals will be evaluated by the Office of Senior Associate Dean for Clinical & Translational Research in collaboration with the Research Advisory Committee with respect to (1) Investigator(s) & Resources, (2) Innovation & Significance, (3) Methods & Analysis, and (4) Budget. Award preference will be given to faculty with no current research support, studies with potential for significant impact on pharmaceutical care, and proposals containing a plan to use study findings in pursuit of future research interests.
