Dr. Gong had worked as a cardiologist and assistant professor in the Capital University of Biomedical Sciences, Beijing, China, before coming to the U.S. in 1986. From 1988 to 2005, he did research in pharmacology, molecular biology, population genetics & cancer genetics at Creighton University in Omaha. He is an author of 41 publications in peer-reviewed journals & an author of two books.

Dr. Zhang received her doctorate in 2005 from Old Dominion University College of Health Sciences after completing her master's degree of medicine at China Academy of Traditional Chinese Medicine. She is a diplomate certified by the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine. She recently received licensure for acupuncture by the Texas Medical Board. Her work is focused on health services research, targeting vulnerable populations of the elderly, women and minorities.
