I. *Old Business:*

A. Pilot Projects for Stage One:

- Project One – Cindy Acton reported two scenarios were video recorded and are currently in the editing process. The students are currently taking the pre-survey. The IT lecture and main IT lab will be held on July 14th. Have set-up a small group of students to discuss the tool with Susan Duncan and/or Kari Woods next week. Students are preparing for the IT lab, however the questions previously prepared for the scenario discussions may have to change based on the final videos. Students will take a post survey by the end of July. Cindy Acton will attempt to show final videos and assignment at the next Faculty Champion meeting.
- Barbara Sawyer suggested for everyone on the pilot project one to meet with Rebecca Sleeper one on one. Carla Myers explained curriculum mapping for Barbara Sawyer as requested. Barbara Sawyer will be meeting with program Directors in September. At the faculty development seminar in fall will learn what every Allied Health program consists of. Will look into video recording seminar as requested. Also, will learn academic standards at the Academic Affairs meeting.
- Project Two & Three – Carla Myers reported Rebecca Sleeper requested everyone send what they have on their curricular materials in electronic form so she can add to the spreadsheet.

B. Faculty Tool Kit:

Carla Myers handed out a chart she developed that will include resources for students and faculty. In essence will be the QEP library. Any faculty who has met the curriculum for a student learning objective will be able to go, lift, and drop QEP data into their course curriculum via password on website.

Purpose - Faculty Champions agreed to the following objectives to be covered at the workshop by the invited speakers, Amy Blue and David Howell from the Medical University of South Carolina:

Day 1:

1. Explore options for integrating Interprofessional teamwork activities into various curricula.
2. Assist faculty champions in the implementation of educational programming related to Interprofessional teamwork.
3. Explore research opportunities related to the Interprofessional teamwork initiative.
4. Explore how to develop ways of introducing interprofessional teamwork within and without the formal curricula.

A. Interprofessional Student Organization at TTUHSC- Herb Janssen reported still in planning stages and Kathryn Horn, Director of Student Affairs in El Paso agreed to help. The group might follow the framework of “Unity Among Us” which is social group in Lubbock campus but with a slant toward developing an interprofessional team theme. This will serve as interprofessional training outside of regular curriculum and open sharing learning experiences. If similar organizations could be developed throughout the system it would allow the group to explore disciplines that only exist at other campuses.

B. Dr. Nunez proposed to arrange an hour meeting for Faculty Champions with Dr. Cerqueira, during her visit on September 9, 2009 in Lubbock. Dr. Cerqueira is Deputy Director of the Pan-American Health Organization and has her office in El Paso. This is the only World Health Office on the 2000 mile US/Mexico border.
