● ● PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS ● ●

- One international health elective award will be made each calendar year.
- Funding for expenses, airfare, lodging and meals may not exceed \$5,000. The source of funding will be from Ted Hartman Endowed Chair in Medical Education.
- Residents (PGY2 or above) from any Lubbock campus residency program are eligible to apply.
- Up to one month time away to complete the elective will be granted.
- The resident is expected to present his experience on an appropriate forum at TTUHSC on completion of the elective.

Applicants must provide details of the proposed elective to include:

1. Country where elective will be taken
2. Educational benefit to the individual, his/her residency program, and the Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center School of Medicine
3. Letter of support from the individual's residency program director

An ad hoc committee of the Lubbock Graduate Medical Education Committee will review the applications and make recommendations to the full committee for final approval and award.
