

AlcoholEdu for College

Fall 2007 Status:

2,477 students have completed this course as of 8/24/07.

Key Findings from Fall 2006:

Ninety-three percent (93%) of TTU students said they paid attention to the course.

Four-in-five Texas Tech student said that AlcoholEdu helped them feel more prepared to handle situations that might come up in college that involved alcohol and decisions about drinking.

The percentage of students who reported they think about their Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) while drinking increased from 34% to 57%.

3,048 students completed this on-line course.

Key Findings from Fall 2005:

After engaging with AlcoholEdu, TTU students had a higher rate of abstention and lower rates of heavy-episodic and problematic drinking than was true of other students who had not yet had the benefit of completing AlcoholEdu.

Seventy-nine percent (79%) of TTU students said they now know more about Blood Alcohol Content (BAC).

1,802 students completed this on-line course.
