ON-TIME GRADUATION RATES

To calculate on-time graduation rates, TTUHSC students are assigned to expected graduation cohorts based on the first academic period for which a student enrolls in credit hours toward a degree program. For purposes of comparison at an institutional level, students are expected to graduate within a specified number of years based on the level of degree sought.

- Students seeking undergraduate degrees are expected to graduate within 4 years of matriculation at TTUHSC.
- Students seeking masters' degrees are expected to graduate within 5 years of matriculation at TTUHSC.
- Students seeking doctoral and/or professional degrees are expected to graduate within 10 years of matriculation at TTUHSC.

The overall TTUHSC on-time graduation rate for the 2019 Expected Graduated Cohort (EGC) was 90.4%. (This compares to 90.1% in 2018 and 88.0% in 2017.)
