DEADLINE TO SUBMIT: FRIDAY, APRIL 7TH, 2023.

Guidelines:

•Topic: Translational research in its broadest sense of encompassing basic science or clinical research that may be useful and important for nervous system function, disorders and therapeutics is welcome. Please submit your one-page Abstract in any area of biomedical science, clinical research, health-related programs or community outreach. Competition is open to students (undergrad and graduate level) and trainees (non-faculty position) at TTUHSC and TTU. Format: Word documents font size >11pt, not to exceed 1 page; must include title, authors' names and affiliation (TTUHSC/TTU, School, Department/Programs, address). Abstracts and posters from recent local or national meetings (academic year 2022-2023) such as Student Research Week may be submitted.

•Poster Format: 44"x44". **Participants are responsible for printing their own posters. Participants will be responsible for posting up their posters, on their designated panel, before their designated time.** Please be sure to check your email regularly for further instructions and information regarding your scheduled presentation time and poster placement.
