21 ALCOHOL-IMPAIRED DRIVING

Impaired Driving Is an Important Public Health Problem

 In 2020, 11,654 people were killed in motor vehicle crashes involving alcohol-impaired drivers, accounting for 30% of all trafficrelated deaths in the United States. This was a 14.3% increase compared to the number of crash deaths involving alcoholimpaired drivers in 2019.



- 32 people in the United States are killed every day in crashes involving an alcoholimpaired driver—this is one death every 45 minutes.
- The annual estimated cost of crash deaths involving alcohol-impaired drivers totaled about \$123.3 billion* in 2020. These costs include medical costs and cost estimates for lives lost.



Drug-impaired driving is also an important public health problem; however, less is known about the harmful effects of drug-impaired driving compared to alcohol-impaired driving because of data limitations.
