Types of Permits

There are several options for different types of mailings. This list is not all types available, just those we can easily use.

Non-profit

Non-Profit Org. U.S. POSTAGE PAID Lubbock, Texas Permit No. 68 Permit – Our most commonly used type of mail. A mailing that would cost 55¢ to mail first class, can be as low as 15¢ apiece. Minimum number of pieces is 200. All qualifications for non-profit mail MUST be met. Be sure to read **Additional Rules for Permit #68**.

Stamps – Non-profit stamps are available for 5¢ each. In lieu of the permit, stamps are placed on the mail piece. All of the paperwork, preparation and rates are the same. The additional postage is charged to the permit.

Standard

Typically, we only use permit imprints for standard mail. Standard mail is used when the piece does not qualify for non-profit. Please refer to **Additional Rules for Permit #68**.

If there are 500 pieces and they do not qualify for non-profit or standard mail, they will be mailed at first class rates. Using the permit on the left simply by-passes using the meter or stamps for full postage. Use of the permit on the right, saves us a few cents off the full postage rate and everything must be sorted for automation.
