Please join the TTUHSC Office of Global Health for a Fulbright Information Session led by Dr. Courtney Queen as part of the Fulbright Scholar Liaison Network.

The J. William Fulbright Scholar Program is sponsored by the United States Department of State, Office of Educational and Cultural Affairs and serves as an instrument of public diplomacy and international service. The Fulbright Program is considered one of the most prestigious external fellowships for faculty opportunities aiming to build a network of scholars around the world by promoting collaborative research and encouraging international partnerships between academic, and professional, institutions. Understanding the complexities of the Fulbright Scholar application process is critical as it involves many stages of review and more than a year between the time of application and the award period. This seminar provides an overview of the Fulbright Scholar Program, tips for how to navigate the Catalog of Awards of more than 400 unique award opportunities in over 135 countries, and details of the application process.

Courtney Queen, Ph.D. was a Fulbright Scholar at Riga Stradinš University with the Institute of Public Health during the Spring Of 2022. During that time, she resided in Riga, Latvia with her 7-year-old daughter. Dr. Queen is an Assistant Professor of Public Health in the Julia Jones Matthews School of Population and Public Health at TTUHSC and a guest professor at Riga Stradinš University with the Statistical Unit of the Institute of Public Health. She is the J. William Fulbright Scholarship Board campus liaison for TTUHSC, and serves on the Fulbright Scholar Alumni Panel for the annual Europe and Eurasia Pre-Departure Orientation.
