Based on over 700 interviews in Mexican towns where about half the population has left to work in the United States, ***The Other Side of Immigration*** asks why so many Mexicans come to the U.S. and what happens to the families and communities they leave behind. Through an approach that is both subtle and thought-provoking, this documentary provides a perspective on undocumented immigration rarely witnessed by American eyes, challenging audiences to imagine more creative and effective solutions.
