Dr. FitzSimon received both her undergraduate and medical degrees from Texas A&M. She completed her residency in Indianapolis, Indiana at Methodist Hospital/ Riley Children's Hospital, which is now the Indiana University Health Sciences Center. She was in rural practice for 6 years before spending 13 years at the Texas A&M Health Science Center/Scott & White Clinic as an Assistant Professor. While there she taught third and fourth year medical students, served as the Pediatric Residency Program Director, and was Chairman of the Admissions Committee for the medical school. Before joining TTUHSC she spent two years caring for the children of drug addicts (from newborn withdrawal onward) at Legacy Emanuel Children's Hospital in Portland, Oregon. In addition Dr. FitzSimon completed several long assignments as a pediatric hospitalist on the border of Texas in Eagle Pass and in Bethel, Alaska through the Indian Health Service. Her interests include child abuse/sexual assault and foster care.
