Medical and Systemic Challenges in Management of HIV-infected Children in Lesotho, Africa

Justin Berk is a fourth-year medical student who completed a month-long clinical rotation at the Baylor International Pediatric AIDS Initiative (BIPAI) clinic in Lesotho, Africa. He received an MPH from Yale School of Public Health with a concentration in Health Management and Global Health.
