

Kenn Freedman, MD, PhD chose to take a sabbatical year to go to Phnom Penh Cambodia to instruct resident physicians in Ophthalmology. During this presentation, he will share his and his family's experiences living and working in Southeast Asia. He will also discuss the various things he learned about medical missions while teaching in Cambodia and also eventually in Ho Chi Minh City.
