During an 18 month deployment to Iraq which began in March 2003 and ended in July 2004, Michael worked as a Civil Affairs officer on Public Health issues. His unit worked towards restoring the country's battered healthcare system. His presentation will offer a glimpse into his observations and the work conducted during this time in Iraq.
