

## ***Single Jingles: Living with Testicular Cancer***

Jason Morton is a PC Support Unit Manager for TTUHSC's Information Technology. He was diagnosed with testicular cancer (TC), the most common cancer diagnosed in men 15 to 35 years of age, in April 2009. After his diagnosis he became involved with Single Jingles, a testicular cancer foundation.

Single Jingles was founded by Matt Ferstler in 2009. The organization provides education and support to young adult men, in an effort to raise awareness about TC. Their goals are to spread the word about the importance of self-exams and early detection and empower men to openly talk about TC.
