Arts in Medicine: Hope & Healing through the Arts

She has over 20 years' experience working in pediatric medical settings as a music therapist clinician, educator, and researcher, specializing in children with chronic and life-threatening illness.

This presentation will provide an overview of the growing use of arts applications in healthcare settings, highlighting the differentiation between creative arts therapies and arts in health. Specific clinical examples in pediatric medicine will demonstrate how various arts modalities, including music, visual arts, creative writing, and drama can improve the patient experience and enhance quality of life for patients and their families.
