Laptop Requirement

The MPAS program has the requirement that all incoming students must have a laptop computer. Below is a list of the minimum recommendations for your laptop computer hardware.

General Recommendations for Laptop Computers:

- Processor: Intel or AMD processor, 2.0 GHz or greater
- Operating System: Windows 10 or later; Mac OSX10.14 or higher
- Memory (RAM): 8 GB RAM or greater
- Storage: 128 GB hard drive or greater
- Network: 802.11 Dual Band Wi-Fi
- Accessories: Privacy Screen (required for testing)

Laptops must also comply with all ExamSoft requirements as well as the requirements listed below.

- Webcam and microphone. Phones cannot be used as cameras.
- Internet: 2.5 Mbps upload speed
- Note: Examplify will not run on Chromebooks, Android, or Linux operating systems. Examplify does not support touchscreen input devices on Mac or Windows laptops.

As a Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center student, you will have access to several free and/or discounted software downloads. One of the most useful is Microsoft Office. Therefore, it is recommended that you **NOT** purchase Microsoft Office prior to arriving on the TTUHSC campus.
