

Student Disability Services Accommodations

TTUHSC complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA), and as amended in 2008, Section 504 Rehabilitation Act of 1973, and state and local requirements regarding students with disabilities. Under these laws, no otherwise qualified individual with a disability shall be denied access to or participation in services, programs, and activities of TTUHSC solely on the basis of the disability.

To obtain accommodations, qualified students must complete an application (found on the SDS website) and provide documentation to TTUHSC Student Disability Services. Documentation should be from a qualified professional who has knowledge of the student's condition and can speak to the severity of the condition and how it effects daily life activities. After all paperwork is received by Student Disability Services, the student must complete an initial intake meeting with the SDS staff in order to receive accommodations.
