


### WITH YOUR SUPPORT, I CAN...

I came to TTUHSC with already over \$100K in debt from my undergraduate instituion because I utilized government fundings to pay for tuiition as well as living expenses for 4 years (usually subsisting on \$14,000 a year or less every year) because both my parents are medically disabled and unemployed, and I wanted to focus all of my energy on school and extracurricular activities to be competitive for med school rather than work parttime. This scholarship will help decrease that financial burden, and I am very grateful for that.

I thought that the history behind TTUHSC's creation was very inspiring—a medical school built in rural West Texas to help bring more bright and talented minds to serve the under-served people there.
