Employee/Student Exposure

Work/Clinical Restrictions
No restrictions, self-monitor for symptoms.
Recommend testing at 5-7 days from last known exposure Positive test: Isolate for 10 days from positive test Negative test: Quarantine for 14 days from last known exposure Symptomatic: Recommend testing at 5-7 days from last known exposure or once symptoms develop, whichever is earlier Positive test: Isolate until symptom free for 72 hours without use of medications and at least 10 days from symptom onset Negative test: Quarantine until symptom
free for 72 hours without medications and 14 days from last known exposure Student may be required to submit negative test results depending on the clinical site Wear a mask at all times upon return to campus and or clinical sites Quarantine for 14 days from last known exposure Isolate separately in the house if possible Enforce good hand hygiene and cleaning You and the infected individual should wear a mask while in the house, particularly in common areas

Exposure to an employee/student who has tested positive for COVID-19

 You were in contact with that person within 48 hours prior to them testing positive

<u>AND</u>

 Your contact with the person was greater than 15 minutes, face to face with no mask

Asymptomatic:

- Recommend testing at 5-7 days from last known exposure
 - <u>Positive test</u>: Isolate for 10 days from positive test
 - Negative test: Quarantine for 14 days from last known exposure

Symptomatic:

- Recommend testing at 5-7 days from last known exposure or once symptoms develop, whichever is earlier
 - <u>Positive test</u>: Isolate until symptom free for 72 hours without use of medications <u>and</u> at least 10 days from symptom onset
 - <u>Negative test</u>: Quarantine until symptom free for 72 hours without medications <u>and</u> 14 days from last known exposure

Student may be required to submit negative test results depending on the clinical site

Wear a mask at all times upon return to campus and or clinical sites

Definitions:

Quarantine: Used to keep someone who might have been <u>exposed</u> to COVID-19 away from others

Isolation: Used to separate people infected with COVID-19 from those who are not infected
