IPE FALL SYMPOSIUM RECAP

The IPE Fall Symposium serves as the annual interprofessional education (IPE) day for TTUHSC. Over 1,800 faculty, students, staff, and guests participated in the morning keynote session with 1,664 faculty and students participating in the afternoon.

The 2019 Fall Symposium, **Building Resiliency for Interprofessional Practice: A Healthier, Happier You**, included a morning and afternoon session. The morning session featured two national keynote speakers who discussed the importance of wellness and resiliency, promoting strategies and tools to prevent and reduce the impact of secondary trauma in individuals and teams. The afternoon session included a moderated IPE case-based learning activity for interprofessional teams along with team-building activities.

For 2019, the Fall Symposium partnered with the Well Beyond Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP) to highlight the 8 Dimensions of Wellness Model and TTUHSC's new wellness initiatives. Overall, students were very satisfied with the day's events and learning activity.
