

KEY STEPS IN ERROR DISCLOSURE



Team Discusses the Error

- 1.) Acknowledges error
- 2.) Conducts blame-free communication during team conversation
- 3.) Demonstrates team-oriented communication
- 4.) Negotiates differences of opinion collaboratively
- 5.) Recognizes emotional impacts of errors on team members

Team Plans the Disclosure

- 1.) Advocates for full disclosure
- 2.) Plans roles for disclosure
- 3.) Anticipate patient's questions and reactions
- 4.) Plans responses to patient

Team Discloses Error to Patient

- 1.) Conducts explicit disclosure of error to patient (or family)
- 2.) Responds forthrightly to questions about event
- 3.) Apologizes upfront and early in conversation
- 4.) Conducts blame-free disclosure, acknowledges personal role
- 5.) Offers plans to prevent future errors
- 6.) Plans follow up with patient (or family)
