TTUHSC Libraries' Journal Collection

The TTUHSC Libraries contain numerous journals in the medical, nursing, life sciences, psychiatric, and allied health fields. Journals can be available: in both print and electronic formats; only in print; or only in electronic format.

If a journal is only available in print, the Libraries' Circulation department can provide copies. Please contact the Circulation department at your affiliated campus. In Lubbock, the phone number is 806-743-2200; Amarillo: 806-354-5448: El Paso: 915-545-6650; and Odessa: 432-335-5172.

There is a \$0.25 per page charge for this service (\$4.00/max.). Rush service is \$0.50 per page (\$10.00/max.). Copy services offered by the circulation staff may be charged to a department account or be paid on an individual cash or check basis.

How Do I Find Online Articles?

If an article is available electronically, you have several ways of accessing it. You may be able to access the article through the *database* that you are currently searching or through *Gold Rush*.

Databases

The TTUHSC Libraries has numerous full-text databases. CINAHL Plus, EMBASE, PubMed, OVID, Scopus, TexShare, and the Web of Science are just a few of the more commonly used databases.

The link to the article may be called different things in different databases: *HTML Full Text*, *Linked Full-Text*, PDF, or *TTUHSC Online*.

If a database is not full-text or does not provide a full-text link, please consult Gold Rush to see if the TTUHSC Libraries subscribe to the journal.

Gold Rush


Gold Rush enables you to go directly to a full-text journal's link where you can either browse journal issues or search within the publication.

To access Gold Rush, go to the TTUHSC Libraries' home page and locate the *Online Journals* link. Mouse-over this link and you will see a link to *Gold Rush (all TTUHSC online journals)* appear to the left.

Type in a journal's name in the search box and click on "Search".



Each journal listed in Gold Rush will have information regarding format (electronic or print), available years, and if a password is required. Electronic access is available by clicking on the a icon. Print format is indicated by the icon.



If a password and username are required to access a particular journal, click on the link provided to obtain them.

Interlibrary Loan

If the library does not subscribe to a journal, you may request a copy of an article by contacting Interlibrary Loan or by filling out the online ILL request form. To use the online form, mouse-over the "Interlibrary Loan (ILL)" link under *Library Services* and click on the "Online ILL Request Form" link. Only affiliated TTUHSC students, faculty, and staff may utilize this service.

Since these articles are requested from other libraries, please allow 2 to 5 business days for normal requests. There is a \$4.00 per item fee for this service. Rush requests are normally received within 24 hours and

are \$10.00 per item.

Distance Education Students

Photocopies of articles can be mailed to distance education students. If an article is from a journal that is only available in print, please contact the Interlibrary Loan department at your affiliated campus. In Lubbock, the phone number is 806-743-2210; Amarillo: 806-354-5797: El Paso: 915-783-5639; and Odessa: 432-335-5172. There is a \$0.25 per page charge for routine delivery (\$4.00/maximum per request); \$0.50 per page charge for rush service (\$10.00/maximum per request). Articles can be either mailed or faxed and an invoice will be sent.

If an article is from a journal that the library does not subscribe to, you may request a copy of the article by contacting Interlibrary Loan or by filling out the online ILL request form. Routine requests from other libraries are \$4.00 per item; rush requests, \$10.00 per item.
