Online Resources	<p>The following print and online information resources are recommended for patrons as an alternative to the TTUHSC Libraries' website during an Internet outage:</p> <p>Direct access to Pubmed.gov (outside of the TTUHSC server): <a href="http://www.pubmed.gov">http://www.pubmed.gov</a>. Patrons will not be able to see which journals the TTUHSC Libraries own or have full-text access to the journal articles. Patrons can limit PubMed searches to nursing journals by using the Filters feature and selecting "Nursing Journals" in the "Journal Categories" section.</p> <p>The TTUHSC Libraries own the print version of Index Medicus at the Amarillo, Lubbock, and Odessa campus libraries. The print version is only current up to 2004.</p> <p>PubMed Central (<a href="http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/pmc">http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/pmc</a>) and NCBI's Bookshelf (<a href="http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/books">http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/books</a>) provides free access to select biomedical and life sciences journals and ebooks.</p> <p>Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health (CINAHL): No direct access to the database outside of the TTUHSC server. The TTUHSC Libraries do own the print version at the Amarillo, Lubbock, and Odessa campus libraries. The print version is only current up to 2007.</p> <p>Core medical books and journals may be available in print. WorldCat mobile can be used to verify book and journal holdings at the TTUHSC Libraries. Patrons can type this URL into their mobile device's web browser: <a href="http://www.worldcat.org/m">http://www.worldcat.org/m</a>.</p> <p>Distance education students may be able to use local academic libraries depending on library policies. It is best to call the library first. Local public libraries may have access to several of the TTUHSC Libraries' TexShare database subscriptions.</p>
Print Resources	<p>Patrons will be able to access and borrow print resources.</p>
Study Areas	<p>Access to study areas will be available.</p>
Web Page	<p>Patrons should look for updates on the TTUHSC announcements page along with the TTUHSC Libraries' Facebook page, RSS feeds, Twitter, and proxy server log-on page.</p>
