Borrowing Policies

- A library card is required to check out all materials.
- Books may be checked out for two weeks and may be renewed twice.
- Audiovisual materials may be checked out for ten days and renewed once.
- Reserve items can only be checked out for two hours and cannot leave the library.
- Print journals, models, and reference materials cannot be checked out.
- Books and audiovisual materials may be renewed online via the library catalog, or by calling the library.
- Books may be returned to the circulation desk or book drop, audiovisual items must be returned to the Learning Resource Center.
- Overdue items and items that have been placed on hold by another patron cannot be renewed.
- Overdue books or audiovisual materials accrue a fine of 50¢ per day per item; reserve items accrue a fine of 50¢ per hour per item.
- Lost or damaged items will have a replacement cost, a \$25.00 processing fee, and all accrued overdue fines.
- Borrowing privileges are suspended until all overdue items are returned and all fines are paid. There is an option for online payment.


