Dr. Nollan gave an update on Texas Consortium of Libraries. University of California has been out of contract with Elsvier and lost access to new articles in the publishing Elsevier's journals. Texas Consortium is in the process in negotiating with vendors and with Elsevier. Dr. Nollan is working on to see if it is okay to participate and attend the meetings. Another idea is to do collaboration to gather information if the library participates, the group wants to hire a consultant to help guide through the organization with Elsivier. The library will also need to hire someone full time to manage the licenses.

New Business:

Wade Redman was asked to mention the Up to Date by Simon Williams. The library does not offer Up to Date because of the price. The library does offer DynaMed and Essential Evidence Plus which has some similar resources as Up to Date does.

Daniel Stuart discussed a few things on Open Access sessions; there will be a set of meetings occurring next year conducted by Daniel and Margaret Burnett for the purposes of exploring institutional repository options.
