was rolled out institution-wide. We're now managing a couple dozen computers on 5 campuses. What was initially a library product has become an institutional product. A couple of weeks ago, we purchased our latest upgrade and are now at 8000 seats. Students are pretty happy with it. D. **Department of InterProfessional Education-** They need some volunteers to act as facilitators for their fall symposium on November 4th. Andrew will forward the email.
