Erik- Talked about how the research portion of the OSCE has been replaced by an Introduction to Pubmed seminar for third year medical students.

Erik talked about library outreach program the library will be participating in in 2016. Dr. Saju suggested that the library looks into participating in local Farmer's Market event.

Erik talked about weeding Index Medicus to make more study room for the patrons.

Dr. Joseph suggested that the library either purchase materials on CV building, or teach fourth year students(and residents) how to construct professional CVs. Travis recommended the Writing Center, but Dr. Saju says that the disadvantage of the Lubbock Writing Center is that the turnover is too slow. Dr. Schlabritz-Lutsevich suggested that the students take advantage of local university classes, such as the professional writing classes taught at UTPB.

Travis: Covered Clinical Key as a medical resource that the faculty and students can use in a hospital setting. Gave out handouts to those in attendance related to Clinical Key.

In light of the library's new 3D printer, Dr. Schlabritz-Lutsevich suggested that the printer can be implemented for the annual Research Day(such as in contests for best 3D presentation).

Dr. Joseph talked about how 3D printing is being used in research on how to help implement better ergonomics in surgery.

Dr. Lani Ackerman expressed interest in the librarians playing a more active role at weekly family medicine didactics starting next Wednesday(February 3). She is also implementing an EBM curriculum and requested librarian feedback/assistance. Travis gave her the syllabus to our MIDS bioinformatics class that she can look at.

All the attendees talked about the World Conference of Ultrasound that is scheduled in September in Lubbock Texas. They hope TTUHSC may make a strong presence at the conference.
