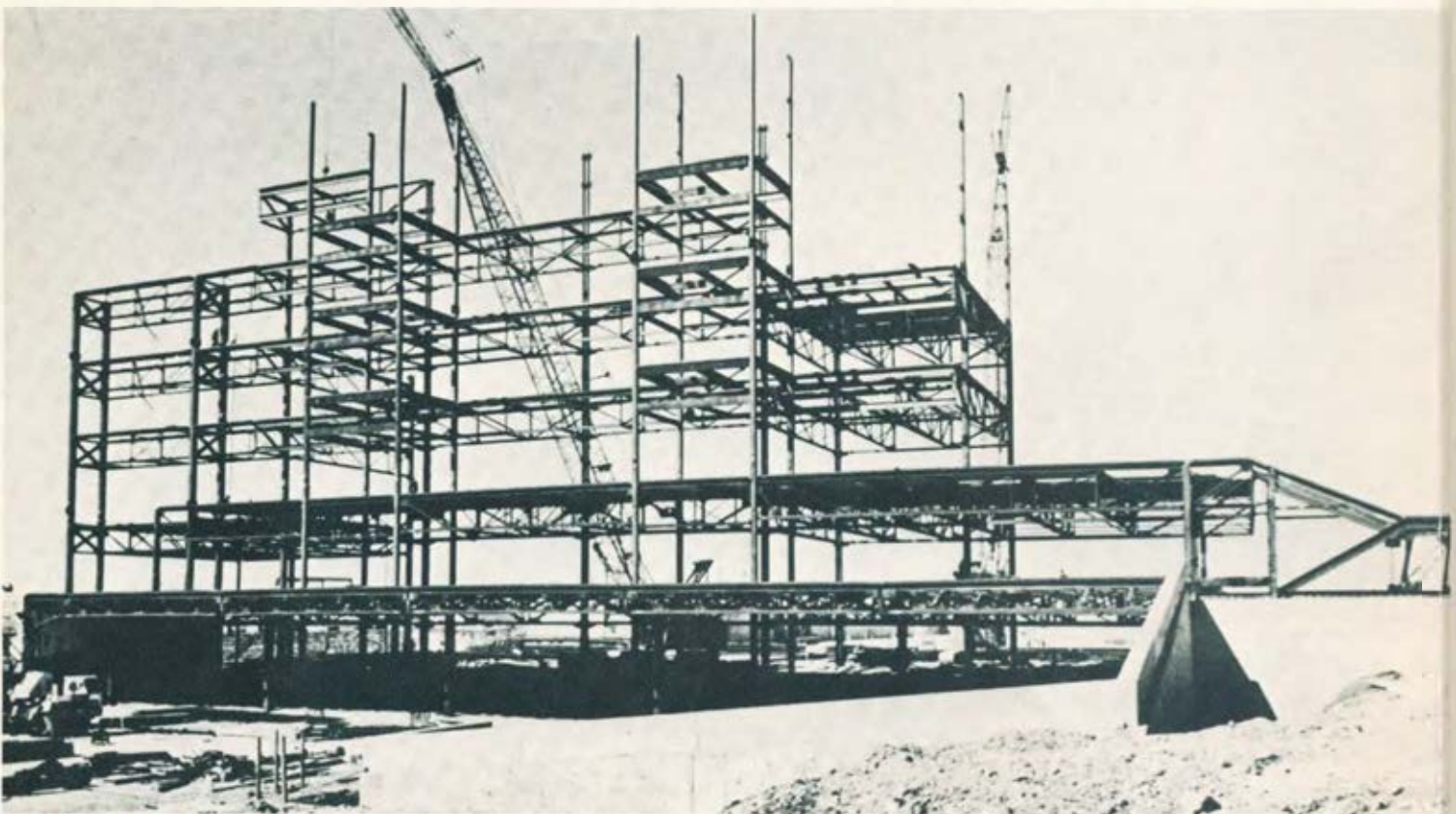

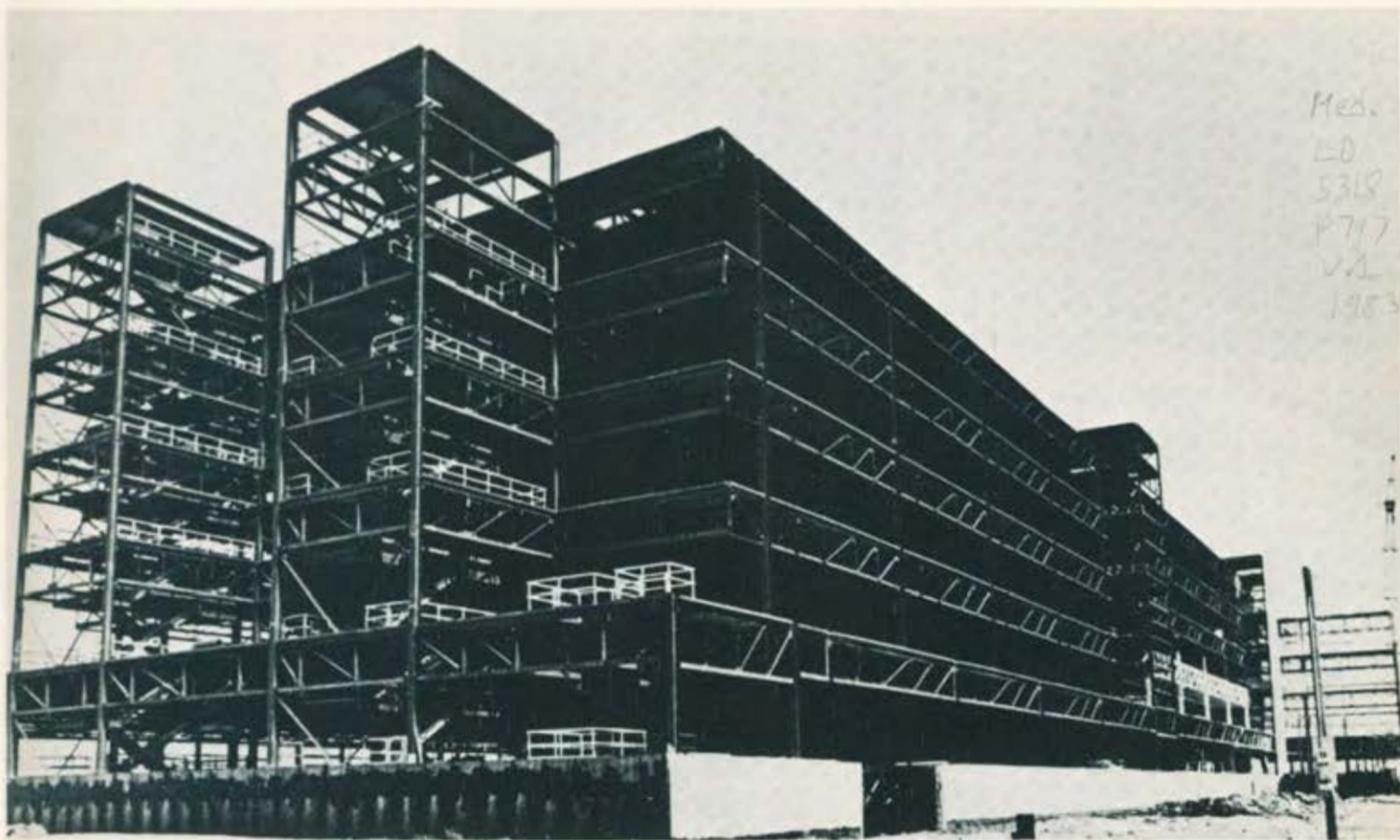

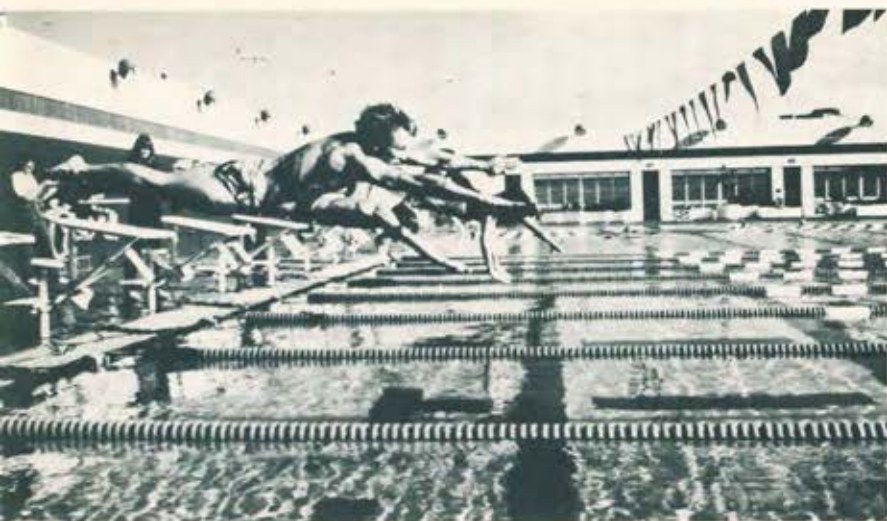

Tarbox Parkinson's Disease Institute

Named after former State Representative Elmer Tarbox, the Tarbox Parkinson's Disease Institute supports educational programs, clinical activities and research associated with the diagnosis and etiology of Parkinson's Disease and related neurological disorders.

Tarbox Fellowship programs fund predoctoral, postdoctoral and medical student research. Awards permit TTUHSC students to conduct research in a faculty member's laboratory. The Clinic is concerned with diagnosis, treatment and monitoring persons with known or suspected Parkinson's Disease. The Tarbox Lecture Series brings speakers to TTUHSC to discuss research activities related to neurological disorders. The Tarbox Institute also sponsors biennial symposia which feature leading international scientists in neurological disciplines.

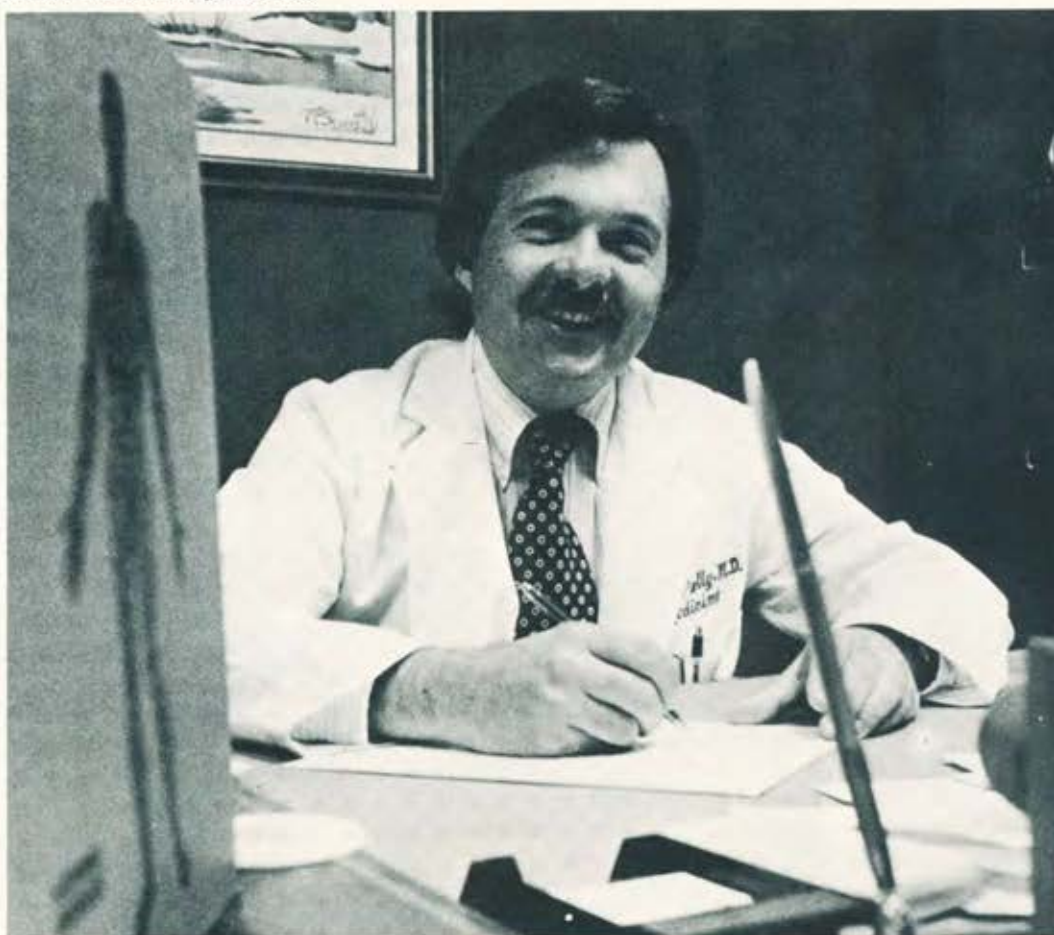

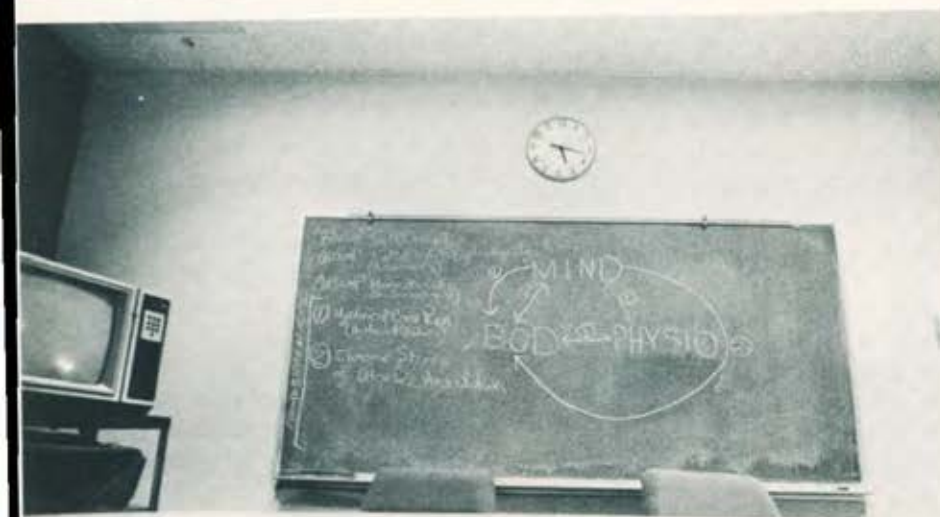

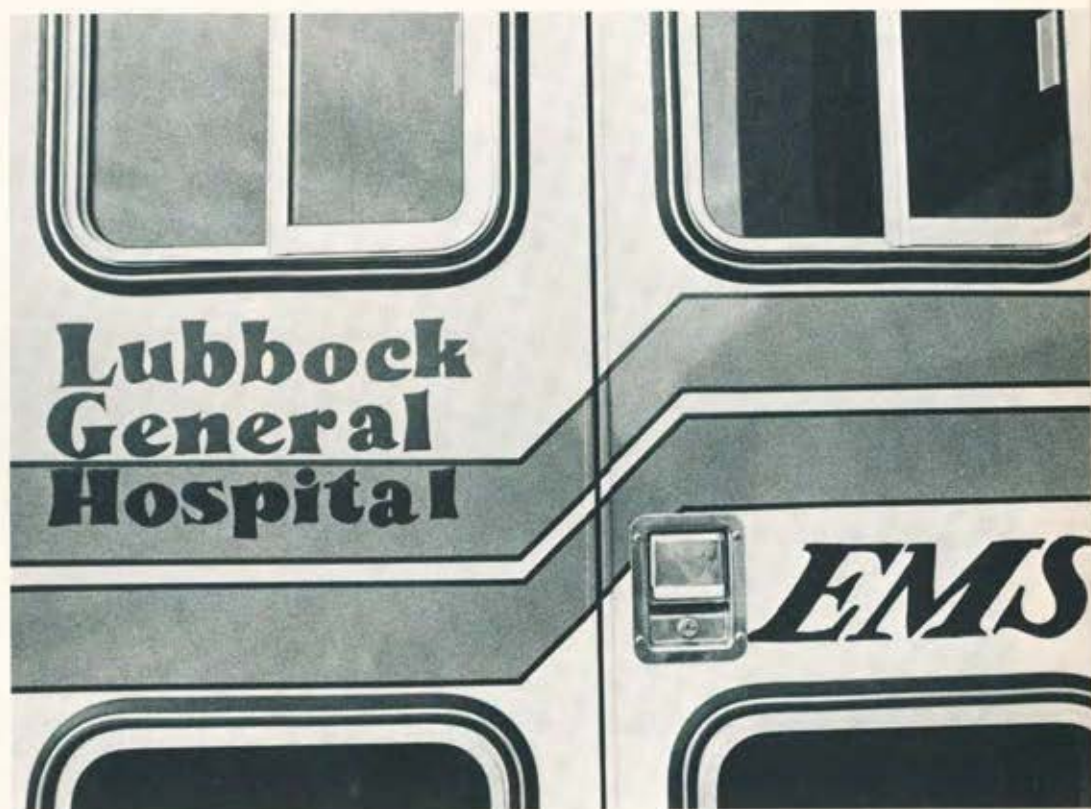

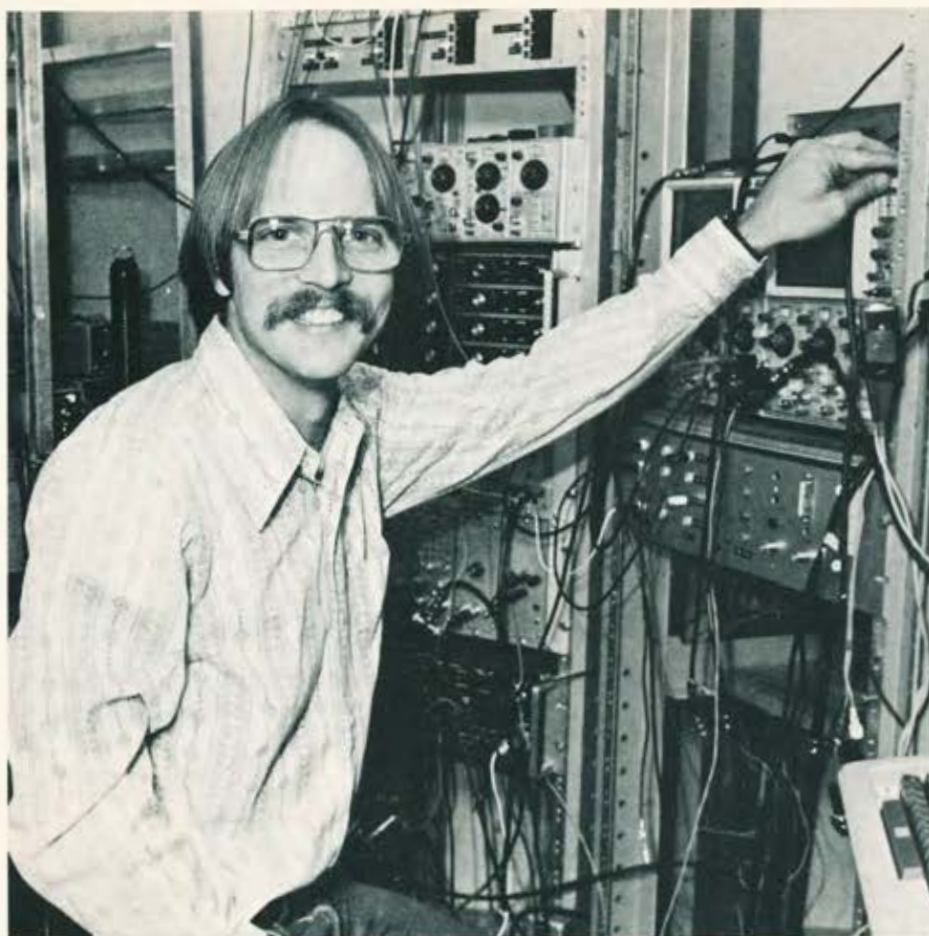
