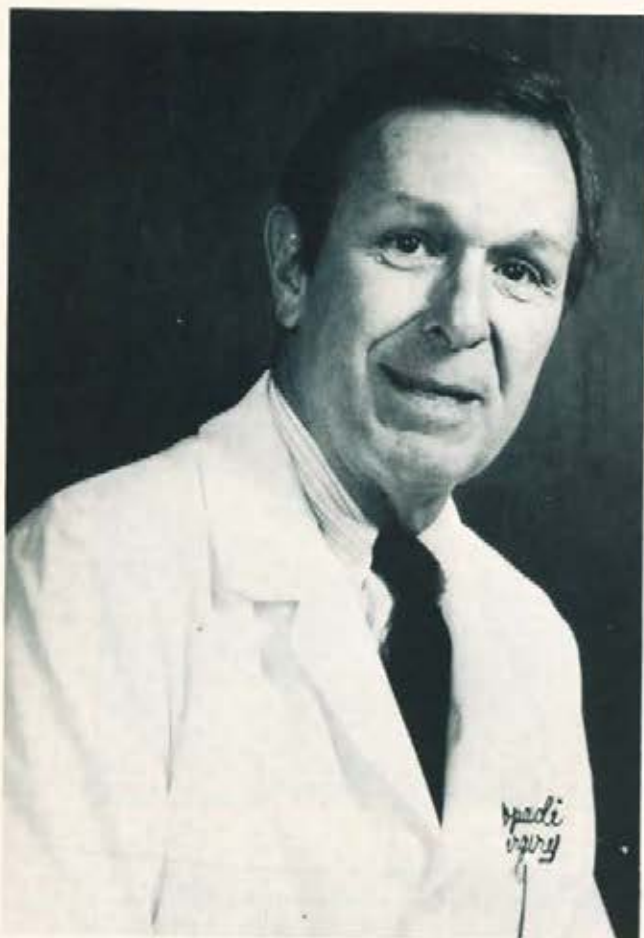
Declaration of Geneva

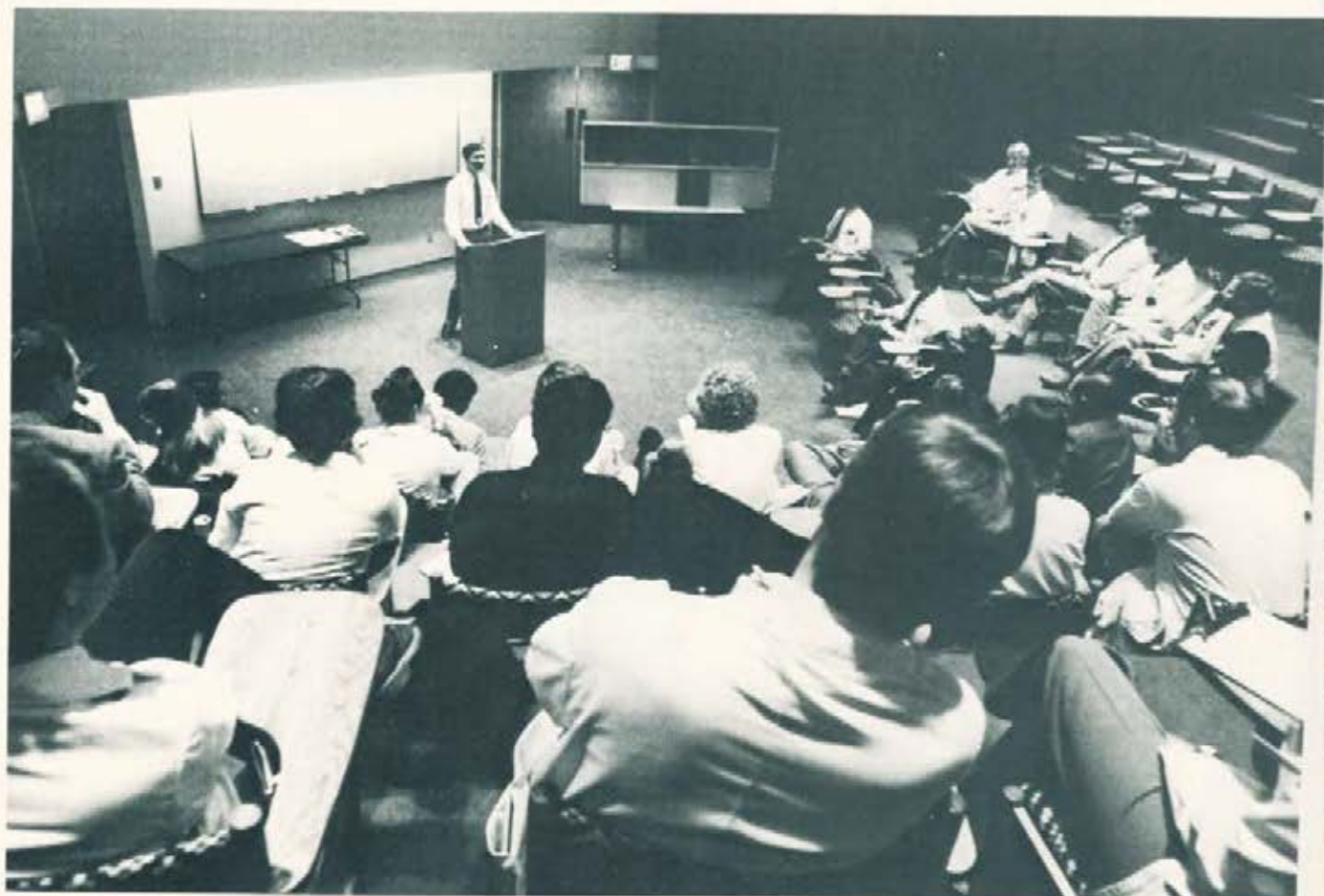
