

## TTUHSC Parking FAQs



### Why do I have to pay for parking?

It is TTUHSC policy. Parking lot upkeep and repairs are funded by these fees.

### What forms of payment can I use to purchase a permit?

Exact cash, check, money order, or credit/debit card (online only). Make checks and money orders payable to TTUHSC for the exact amount due. We are only able to accept credit or debit cards as payment online via the Parking Services website.

### How do I enroll for payroll deduction to pay for my parking? (employees only)

Access your Employee Parking Dashboard online and follow the instructions for enrolling. Deduction renews automatically each fiscal year. <https://www.fiscal.ttuhs.edu/Parking>

### Where should I place my parking permit?

On the inside of your windshield on the lower left driver's side, above or below your Texas vehicle registration sticker.

### I have a parking permit, but I'll temporarily be driving a vehicle that does not have a permit, i.e. a rental car, spouse's car, parent's car, etc. What do I need to do about parking on campus?

- **For one day only:** send an email to [abileneparking@ttuhsc.edu](mailto:abileneparking@ttuhsc.edu), providing the make, model, color, year, license plate of the temporary vehicle, and date you will be parking it on campus.
- **For more than one day:** come by the F&A Office for a temporary permit.

### I will not be driving the car that I registered with TTUHSC any longer, due to a wreck, the purchase of a new car, etc. What do I need to do about my parking permit?

1. Remove the parking permit from your original vehicle and place it on the new vehicle.
2. Update all vehicle information on the Parking Services website for the new vehicle you will now be driving. Your parking registration will not be valid until you update this information. <https://www.fiscal.ttuhs.edu/Parking>
3. If the permit no longer adheres on its own or it is no longer fully intact, bring the permit to the F&A Office to obtain a replacement permit. You may also obtain a replacement permit if you are unable to retrieve the permit from your vehicle.

### I have to replace my windshield. What do I do about my permit?

Ask the repair company to transfer your permit and other stickers to the new windshield. If this is not possible, remove the permit and bring it to the F&A Office and purchase a replacement permit for a \$2 fee.

### I do not wish to purchase a parking permit. Where I can park?

- You may park at your own risk on the streets surrounding the TTUHSC campus. Many of the streets allow parking on only one side of the street, so watch for informational signs placed by the city. A map showing commonly used areas is included in the Parking Information Packet.
- Parking in the lots of surrounding businesses is prohibited, including any of Hendrick Medical Center's 27 parking lots.

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
