FREE CLINIC

HOSTED BY LUBBOCK IMPACT, INC.

The Free Clinic is an urgent care clinic that provides free basic health care to the working poor and homeless population in Lubbock. The clinic is run by physician and medical student volunteers one evening each week. A variety of volunteer opportunities await students at TTUHSC.

Whether you are a first- or fourth-year medical student, you will gain valuable experience with patient-doctor interaction, performing medical exams and more!

Health care services are offered at no cost to the patient, while staff, counseling, and prescriptions are provided by Lubbock Impact. Since opening its doors, the clinic has treated over 3,000 unique patients in more than 6,000 patient visits, averaging 25-30 patients a week. The clinic is open every Wednesday evening.

The Free Clinic is helping to close the health care gap in Lubbock.

INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMS FOR STUDENTS:

TTUHSC offers a diverse array of international health opportunities in conjunction with medical coursework. These opportunities include faculty-led programs, institutional programs at approved sites and self-identified sites.

FACULTY-LED PROGRAMS:

Faculty-led programs are designed by faculty who administer the programs abroad and are responsible for recruiting students. The programs are offered throughout the year. Current sites include Jamaica, Nicaragua, Peru and India.

INSTITUTIONAL PROGRAMS AT APPROVED SITES:

Opportunities are also available at sites with which TTUHSC has an ongoing collaborative relationship and pre-approved health-related organizations. Locations include: Costa Rica, India, Nicaragua, Thailand and Vietnam.

SELF-IDENTIFIED SITES:

To allow students the flexibility of selecting a program that meets their personal and professional goals, TTUHSC offers a process for approving self-identified sites. These are sites not currently being utilized by TTUHSC, but which are selected by students to meet their individualized needs.
