

# DOCTOR OF MEDICINE

The 4-year curriculum consists of two years of fundamental principles of medical sciences divided into subject blocks. Students focus on individual areas of curriculum while exploring professional, ethical and clinical areas of medicine through Development of Clinical Skills (DOCS) and Patients, Physicians and Populations (P3) activities. Flexibility is built into the final year of the medical school curriculum and allows a custom clinical experience focusing on student interest. Learning occurs in classrooms, small group forums and community-based settings.

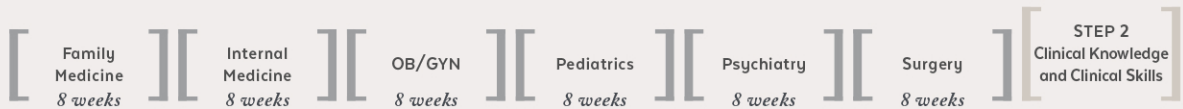
