

DOCTOR OF MEDICINE / MASTER IN PUBLIC HEALTH

The M.D./MPH emphasizes the knowledge and skills of core public health fields and the integration to public health practice. A Master in Public Health can be received by completing a minimum of 45-credit hours, including a practicum experience and a research or thesis project. At this time, the MPH program offers majors in social and behavioral sciences, epidemiology or general public health. Students have the option to complete the MPH program between the third and fourth year of medical school.
