

MULTI-CAMPUS SYSTEM

TTUHSC multi-campus provides ample opportunity for learning under some of the best physicians in Texas. All medical students spend the first two years in Lubbock; third- and fourth-year students receive clinical training in Lubbock, Amarillo or the Permian Basin (Midland/Odessa).

LUBBOCK

Students who remain in Lubbock may be assigned to one of the two locations below.

UNIVERSITY MEDICAL CENTER: Our partnership with UMC provides West Texas and Eastern New Mexico with the best possible care. UMC is the only Level 1 Trauma Center for the area serving a geographical region larger than most states in the U.S.

COVENANT HEALTH SYSTEM: The region's largest health system, which serves approximately 1.2M people. Covenant Children's Hospital is the only comprehensive freestanding children's hospital in the area.
