INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO RECEIVE CREDIT

In order to receive IPCE Credit, AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™ or Attendance hours for non-physician, attendees must:

- 1. Attend the conference on Saturday, October 7, 2023. Be sure to electronically sign in.

- You have been registered for this conference in the TTUHSC CAICME database system and you already have a record in our system.
- As you log-in to **My Portal** there will be directions regarding signing in to your account. The email address you received the registration confirmation email for this conference is associated with your records. Be sure to use that email address.
