INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO RECEIVE CREDIT

In order to receive *AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™* attendees must:

1. Attending in person: Sign-in at the registration table when you arrive at the conference.
Attending Virtually in ZOOM: you must log in with your full name, credentials, and email.
2. If you wish to receive full credit or if you are seeking CEUs, you must attend the entire conference including the Q&A session at the end.
3. Must complete and submit the Credit Request Form located on the conference website.
 - The Office of CME reserves the right to adjust credit awarded, should ineligible credit be claimed.
4. The Conference Evaluation will also be available online and can be completed as you attend sessions throughout the day.
5. **The online Credit Request form and the online Evaluation will be available for 1 week until 11:59 PM on Sunday, May 15, 2022.** After this date, if you have not already claimed your credit, please contact the CME Office for an alternate method for claiming credit.

CERTIFICATES and TRANSCRIPTS
