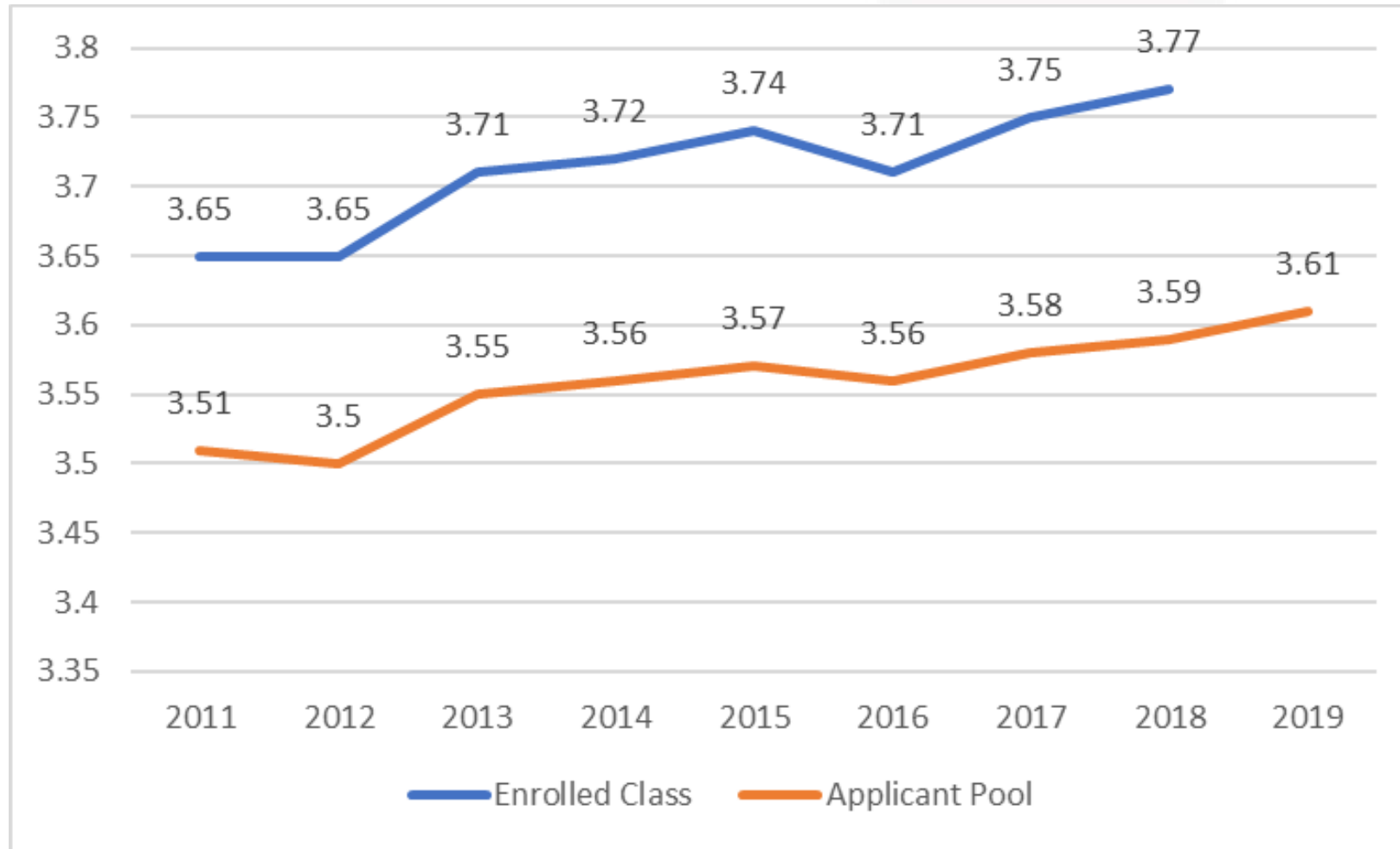

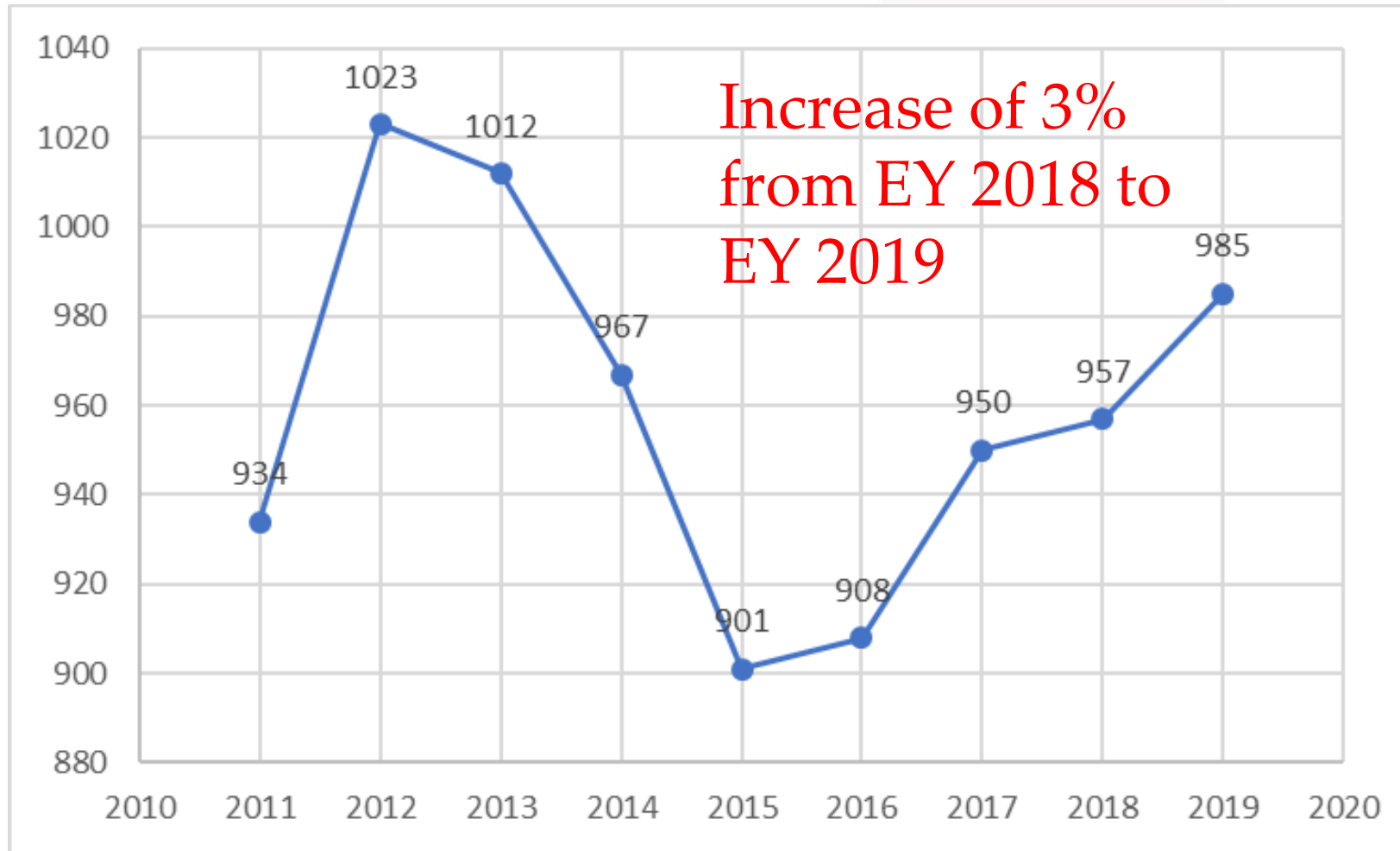


Dental School Admission Statistics

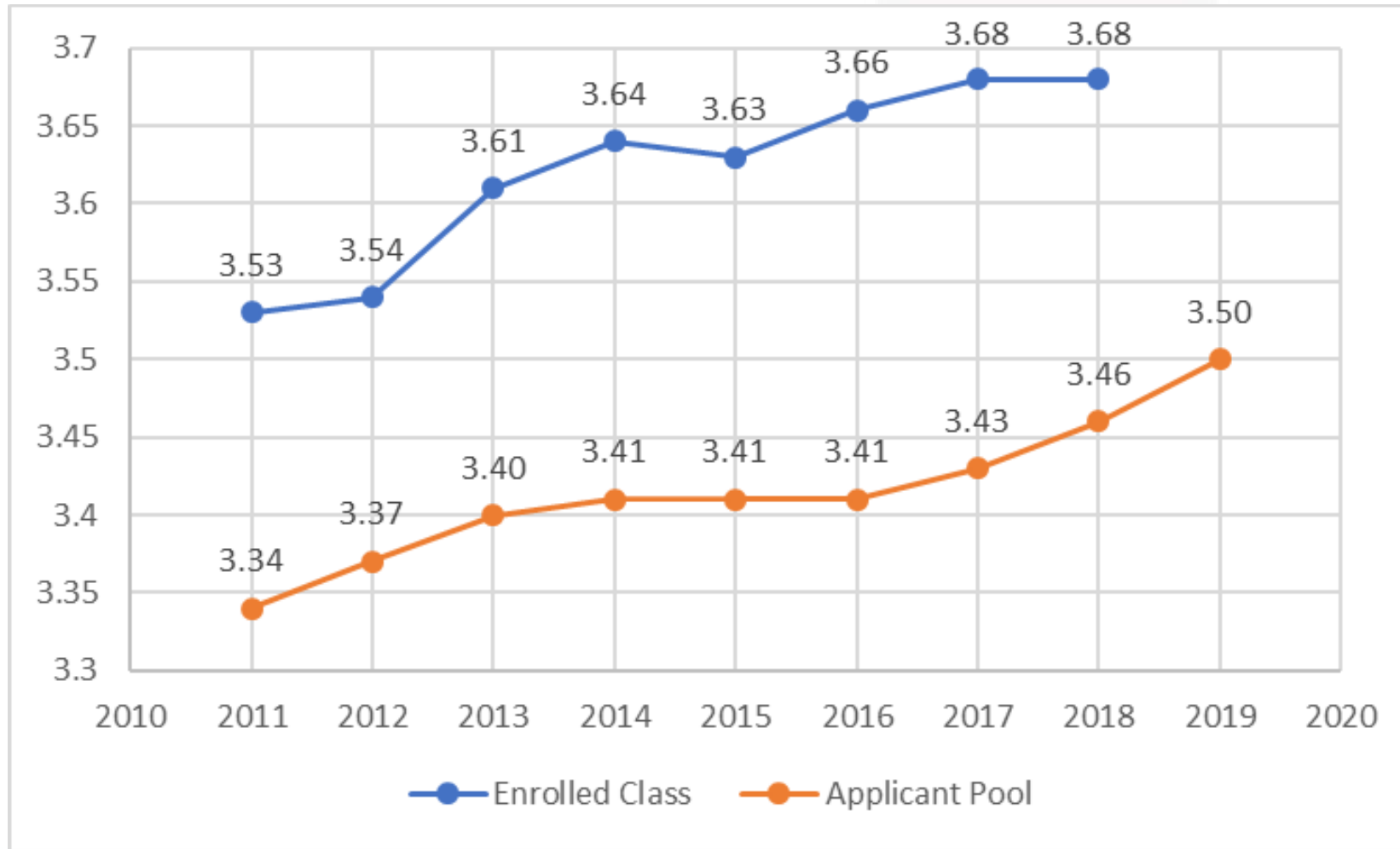

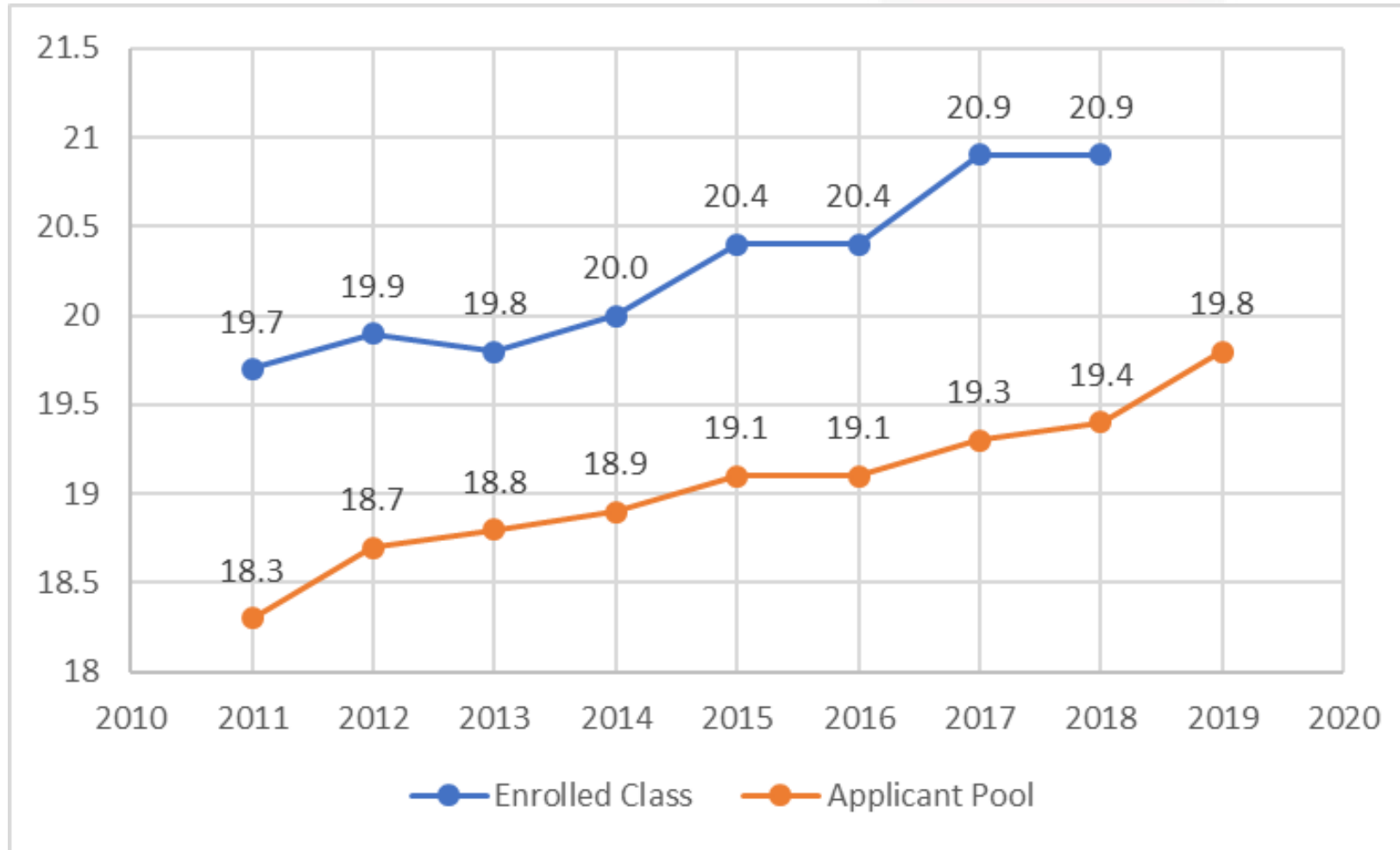

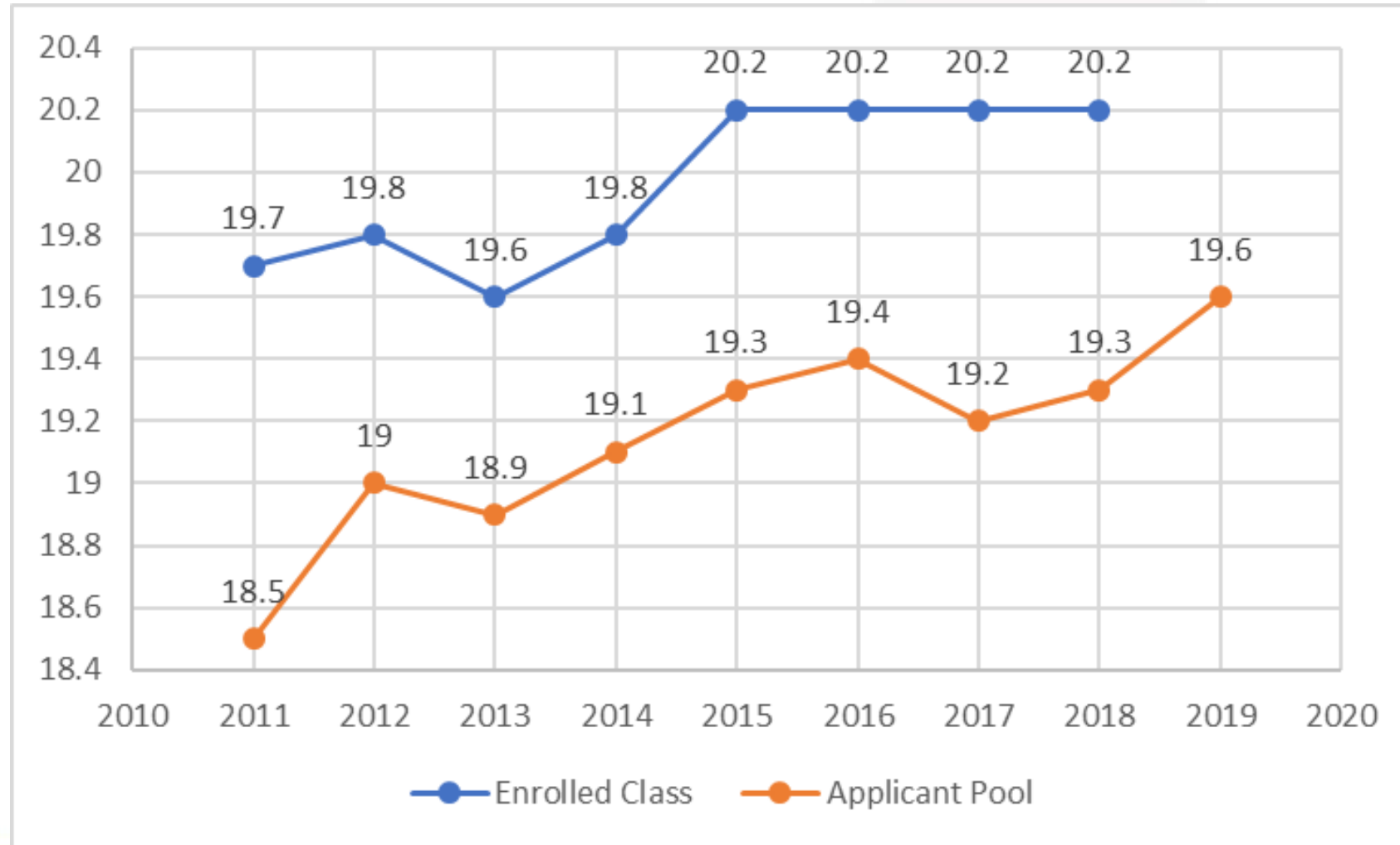
GPA Averages

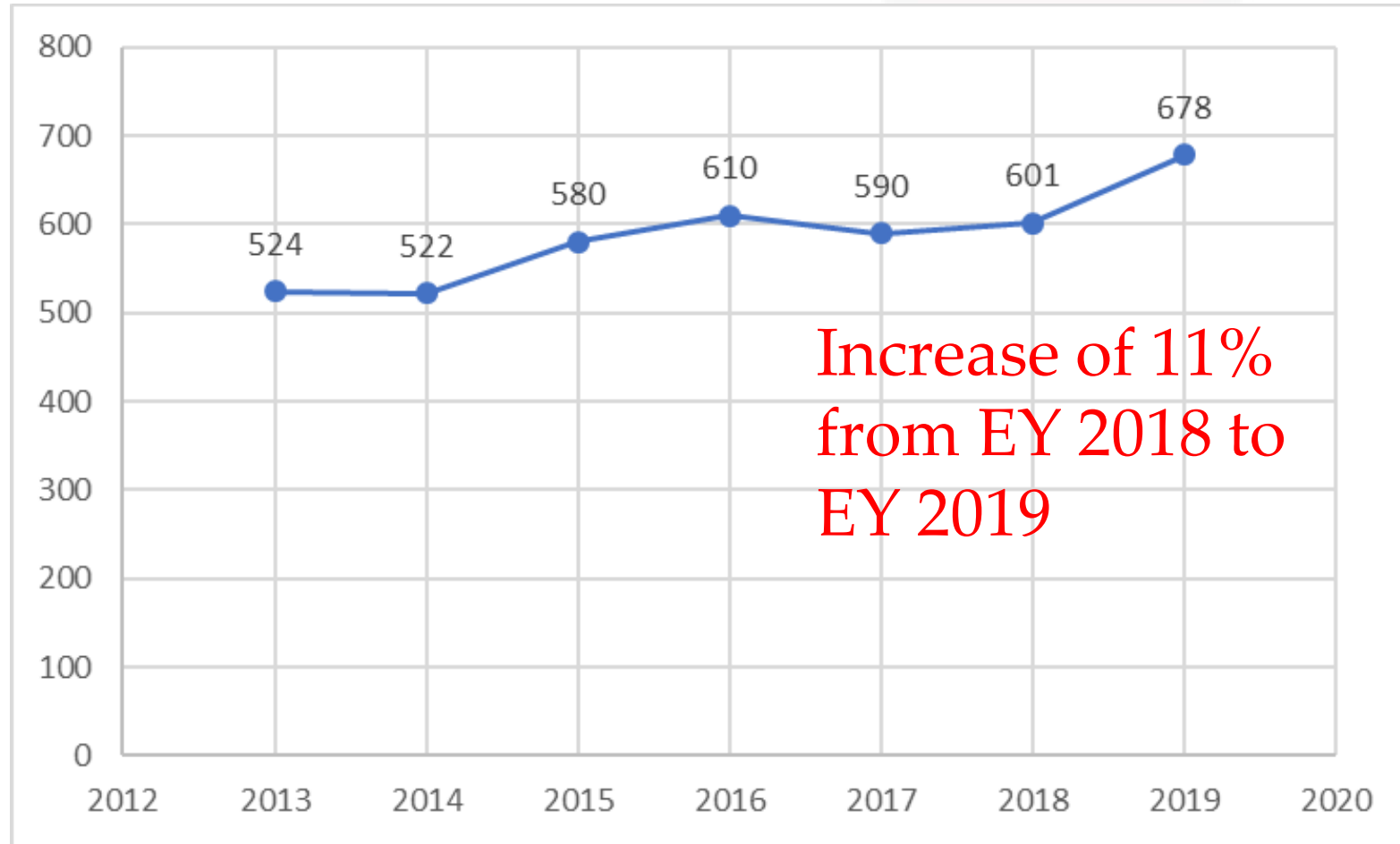
