- Under-insured or not insurance
- Income must not exceed 200% above poverty level
- South Plains Clinics (18+ counties)

➤ Services Provided

- Financial Assistance for breast and cervical health screenings
 - Texas Medicaid for Breast & Cervical Cancer
- Mammograms, Breast Ultrasounds, Breast Biopsies, Colposcopies, Cervical Biopsies, Cervical Dysplasia Treatment

Clients' Health Needs

- Breast & Cervical Cancer Screenings & Treatment
- Men don't qualify for breast cancer treatment assistance

Clients' Health Information Needs

- Post Cancer Issues
 - Mental & Psychological Changes
 - Life Changes
 - Long Term Treatment Effects
- Early Screening and Diagnosis
