- STTI has more than 135,000 active members.
- Members reside in more than 85 countries.
- 39 percent of active members hold master's and/or doctoral degrees; 51 percent are in staff positions; 19 percent are administrators or supervisors; 18 percent are faculty/academics; and 12 percent are in advanced practice.
- There are roughly 500 chapters at approximately 695 institutions of higher education around the world.
- STTI communicates regularly with more than 100 nurse leaders who have expressed interest in establishing chapters globally.
