

## ENROLLMENT MANAGEMENT

The TTUHSC School of Pharmacy and the TTU Rawls College of Business reserve the right to limit the number of accepted applications into the PharmD/MBA program. All pharmacy students desiring to enroll in the PharmD/MBA program will first complete a School of Pharmacy application for the MBA program. A Selection Committee consisting of faculty and staff members will evaluate the students' academic performance of the applicants and compile a recommendation list to the Rawls College of Business. Those students whose academic performance does not reach the level of a recommendation will be counseled on other opportunities that may exist.

Student achievement in pharmacy courses and/ or other courses taken at other universities will serve as the basis for determining the acceptability of an applicant. PCAT scores will also be considered. Students will not be required to take the GMAT examination or interview with School of Pharmacy faculty. All students desiring to enroll in the PharmD/MBA program must have a previous baccalaureate degree.
